

Maths – The units we will be covering over this term are:

Place Value

Addition and Subtraction

Multiplication and Division

Fractions

We will also be completing daily arithmetic sessions to enhance recall of key facts as well as increasing the speed of this recall. It is imperative the children continue to work hard to memorise and retain all of the times tables facts from the 1x to 12x table. Please continue to support your child in learning these at home and if they can recall them all then please continue to work on developing speed when answering these questions. TT Rockstars is a great resource to use. Each term the children will receive a KIRFs document outlining key facts that they also need to be able to recall quickly. Once again if you can spend some time looking at these with your child, I would be very grateful.

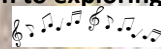
English – Children will have daily reading, writing and spelling lessons. They will receive weekly spellings which will be tested– please support your child to learn and use their spellings at home. Reading at home is also a school expectation and helps your child to achieve their genre bookmarks as well being a big help in aiding their writing skills.

The first book we will read will be 'Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief' which we will use to inspire our descriptive writing skills. Time will also be spent focusing on handwriting skills.

Science – In the first half term we will be investigating the unit of living things and will, in particular, be investigating reproduction and life cycles of plants. A large majority of this learning will take place in a practical manner during our Forest School lessons. Connections will then be made to our following unit of the life cycles and reproduction of animals.

Music – In Music we will start by listening to and appraising 'Livin' on a Prayer' and the genre of Rock before moving on to exploring the genre Jazz.



Spanish – In Spanish we will start the year by looking at vocabulary linked to favourite foods followed by language linked to sports.



Art and DT – To start the term, we will be exploring both modern and Ancient Greek food. We will explore a variety of dishes and then design and create our own Greek inspired dish. Following this, we will use printing techniques to develop our own Ancient Greek inspired pattern and image.



Computing – To start the term we will be spending time making sure the children are aware of ways to ensure they are staying safe online. We will then look at networks, databases as well as finishing the term with blogging.



History – Throughout the term, we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks. We will look at such topics as daily life, food, Gods and myths. We will also spend some time looking at the influences that Ancient Greece have had on life today.

PSHCE – We will be starting the year by giving the children the chance to explore families and relationships followed by looking at health and wellbeing in the next term.

PE – In this term we will start by developing our ball and agility skills to help to progress our football skills. In the following half term, we will develop our dynamic balance skills to support our independent and partner gymnastics.



RE – In the first term the unit will be exploring the big question 'What does it mean if God is holy and loving?' We will be exploring thoughts of Christians as well as the Bible. Following this, we will explore 'Creation and Science; conflicting or complimentary?'
